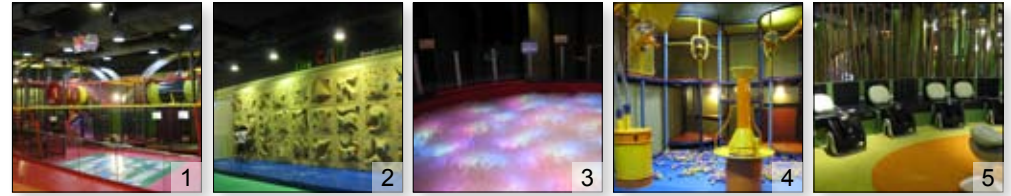


# EXPLORERKID FAMILY PARK



## ExplorerKid Family Park at a Glance

Located on the third level of E!hub at Downtown East, ExplorerKid Family Park is Singapore's largest themed indoor playground a 35,000 sq ft. The Park's activities cater mostly to children aged five to 12 years. However there are limited activities for infants and toddlers.

First stop is the Shoe Store where you deposit your shoes and stroller. Bring your own socks or you'll have to buy a pair at \$2. If you're visiting with kids of various ages, you can let the older ones loose to explore the various activity stations. There are staff on-hand to keep the mischief in check. If you have a tot with you, the toddler play area or lit ball pool is probably your next stop.

ExplorerKid is open from Monday to Thursday, noon to 10pm during off-peak hours and Friday to Sunday from 10am to 10pm during peak hours. These hours also apply for eve of public holidays, public holidays, gazetted school holidays and PSLE marking days. Fees range from \$9 for an ExplorerKid member to \$22 per child-public.

## 1. Mega Play

This is probably the first activity for your child upon entering the Park. Children can climb, jump, crawl, bounce and just get mega-exhausted in this three-storey play structure. Best for kids from 4 to 12 years.

## 2. The Cliff

Perfect for little climbers, the Cliff is a rock-climbing wall for kids to build strength, agility, balance, and boost their self-confidence.

## 3. Toddler Play & Lit Ball Pool

The toddler play area has some rockers, foam blocks and rides but your tots will probably find the large lit ball pool more entertaining.

## 4. Extra Fee, Extra Fun

Let your children test their agility and balance at Adventure Highlands. A minimum height of 120cm is required. Cost is \$5.50 per circuit.

For kids five to 12 years, get their heart rates up at Ball 'O' City as they shoot and duck in a pen filled with about 2000 soft-foam balls priced at \$5.50 per half hour.

Want to experience the feel of ice-skating? The 2000 sq ft synthetic ice-skating rink provides a safe venue to learn this graceful sport. Fees start at \$5.50 per hour for children from four to 12 years and \$3 for skate rental. Prices vary for public, NTUC members, and ExplorerKid members.

## 5. A Break for Adults Too

What makes ExplorerKid a tad different is its adult-only offerings. Adults pay \$1.50 to enter the Park but for an extra fee (\$2.50 per half hour), you can take a nap at Slumberland, get a back or foot massage at The Mound, or watch a DVD at The Cocoon. These services allow parents to get some down time nearby while their kids are at play. A cafe and some Internet stations located near the cafe seating are also available.
