

PASIR RIS PARK AREA 3



Pasir Ris Park Area 3 at a Glance

Pasir Ris Park is very large and is divided into three main areas. There are many fun activities it offers including an opportunity to feed and ride ponies and you can even visit a mangrove swamp (Area 2). However, if you have a baby or young children, consider going to Area 3 of the Park where a very large playground is located. The playground alone will entertain your children for hours.

The beach will not disappoint too for those wanting to have a picnic or relaxing stroll. A shower and restroom facility makes it easy to wash up before heading home.

You can even rent a kayak to enjoy some paddling time in the sea, then take a snack or meal break at the food and beverage outlet before heading home. It's also a pleasant venue to do some cycling and jogging.

If you are driving, you will enter via car park D. Drive further in to car park F if you want to be closer to the playground. You can also parallel park on the road as well.

1. Play for All Ages

The playground is located close to Pasir Ris Road so you won't miss it once you arrive. There are challenging play areas for all ages. It will be hard to decide where to start! For toddlers, there are bucket swings to enjoy and also a maze great for peek-a-boo play. The maze panels have various character portrayals with face cut-outs so your child can put his face through and let you capture a photo of him as the character.

Older children will enjoy the obstacle courses that are nestled amongst nature. Look for a long metal slide that you can ride to give you a feel of sliding down a tree! Climbers will not be disappointed with a small hill with a rock wall on one side and slide on the other. Many other climbing opportunities are also available in different play areas.

2. Picnic by the Beach

Barbeque pits are located near the beach so you can enjoy a relaxing beachfront barbeque or picnic. The water is relatively clean and safe for swimming. A nearby restroom with shower facility makes it easy to clean up too.

3. 3-seater Kayaks

Located just outside the food and beverage venue, Beach Culture @ Watercross, is a kayaking rental business called Adventure Paddlers. They boast the only opportunity to rent 3-seater kayaks so you can safely take your child along. There is no age restriction but your child must be able to understand and obey instructions, and weigh less than 45kg. According to the staff, it is safest to kayak in these waters since it is a relatively confined area and not the open sea. For details, go to www.adventurepaddlers.com.sg.

4. Food and Beverage Break

Located near the beach is food and beverage outlet Beach Culture @ Watercross. The restaurant serves a kid's menu of western favourites starting at about \$8 per selection. The restaurant also caters for parties. Go to www.beachculture.com.sg for details.
